NEW BUSINESS ITEMS

2. 2025 Capital Budget

A motion was made by Verveer, seconded by Ring to approve the 2025 Capital Budget. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

3. Budget Discussion

Two questions were asked regarding the budget, did the renovation stay within budget and is the video wall that has been used in past events leased or owned by Monona Terrace. To answer the first question, the renovation work has stayed within budget. Staff makes sure not to go over budget with any of the capital projects, even if that means reducing the scope of the project or pushing it out to future years. Second, the video wall that's been used at events in the past is a leased item. The AV department manager's research suggests that the cost of a video wall would be paid back in 2-3 years of rental fees. It is modular and the technology is here to stay. As noted in the memo, the City of Madison will be funding 2025 capital projects partially through the Room Tax Fund and partially through general obligation (GO) borrowing. Alder Verveer reminded the committee that GO debt is required for the city to impose a 10% Room Tax.
