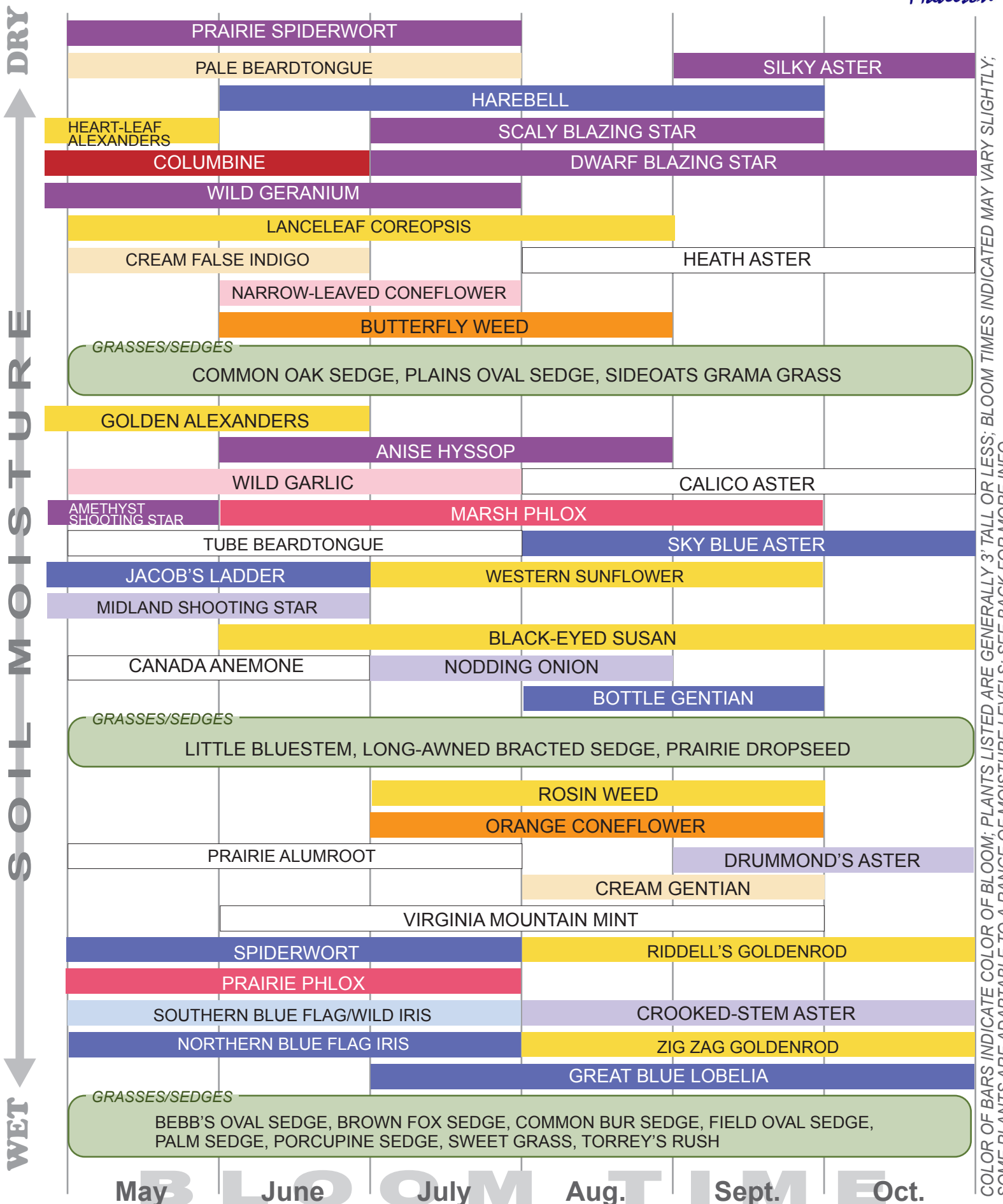


RAIN GARDEN PLANTS FULL SUN 6+ Hours

Top (dry)

- *Butterfly Weed (*Asclepias tuberosa*) – 2' – Orange – Jun-Aug – Dry-Med
- *Columbine (*Aquilegia canadensis*) – 2' – Red/yellow – Apr-Jun – Dry-Med
- Cream False Indigo (*Baptisia bracteata*) – 2' – Cream – May-June – Dry-Med
- Dwarf Blazing Star (*Liatriis cylindracea*) – 1' – Purple – Jul-Oct - Dry
- Harebell (*Campanula rotundifolia*) – 1' – Purple – Jun-Sep – Dry
- *Heart-Leaf Golden Alexanders (*Zizia aptera*) – 2' – Yellow – Apr-May – Dry-Med
- *Heath Aster (*Aster ericoides*) – 2' – White – Aug-Oct – Dry-Med
- *Lanceleaf/Sand Coreopsis (*Coreopsis lanceolata*) – 2' – Yellow – May-Aug – Dry-Med
- Narrow-Leaved Coneflower (*Echinacea angustifolia*) – 2' – Pink – Jun-July – Dry
- Pale Beardtongue (*Penstemon pallidus*) – 1' – Cream – May-Jul – Dry
- Prairie Spiderwort (*Tradescantia bracteata*) – 1' – Purple – May-July – Dry
- *Scaly Blazing Star (*Liatriis squarrosa*) – 2' – Purple – Jul-Sep – Dry
- Silky Aster (*Aster sericeus*) – 1' – Purple – Sep-Oct - Dry
- Wild Geranium (*Geranium maculatum*) – 1' – Apr-July – Lavender – Dry-Med

Grasses/Sedges

- Common Oak Sedge (*Carex pensylvanica*) – 8" – Dry-Med
- Little Bluestem (*Schizachyrium scoparium*) – 3' – Dry-Med
- Plains Oval Sedge (*Carex brevior*) – 1' – Dry-Moist
- Side-oats Grama Grass (*Bouteloua curtipendula*) – 2' – Dry-Med

Middle (medium)

- Amethyst Shooting Star (*Dodecatheon amethystinum*) – 1' – Violet – Apr-May – Dry-Med
- Anise Hyssop (*Agastache foeniculum*) – 3' – Purple – Jun-Sep – Dry-Med
- *Black-Eyed Susan (*Rudbeckia hirta*) – 2' – Yellow – Jun-Oct – Dry-Moist (use anywhere)
- Bottle Gentian (*Gentiana andrewsii*) – 3' – Blue – Aug-Sep – Dry-Moist
- Calico Aster (*Aster lateriflorus*) – 1-3' – White – Aug-Oct – Dry-Med
- Canada Anemone (*Anemone canadensis*) – 1' – White – May-Jun – Med-Wet
- *Golden Alexanders (*Zizia aurea*) – 3' – Yellow – Apr-Jun – Dry-Med
- Jacob's Ladder (*Polemonium reptans*) – 1' – Blue – Apr-Jun – Dry-Wet
- *Marsh Phlox (*Phlox glaberrima interior*) – 2' – Pink – Jun-Sep – Med
- Midland Shooting Star (*Dodecatheon meadia*) – 18" – Lavender or White – Apr-Jun – Dry-Med
- *Nodding Onion (*Allium cernuum*) – 18" – Lavender – Jul-Aug – Dry-Moist
- *Ox-Eye Sunflower (*Helianthus occidentalis*) – 3' – Yellow – July-Sep – Dry-Med
- *Sky Blue Aster (*Aster azureus*) – 3' – Blue – Aug-Oct – Dry-Med
- *Tube Beardtongue (*Penstemon tubiflorus*) – White – 3' – May-Jul – Dry-Med
- Wild Garlic (*Allium canadense*) – 18" – Pink – May-July – Dry-Moist

Grasses/Sedges

- Long-Awned Bracted Sedge (*Carex gravida*) – 2-3' – Dry-Med
- Prairie/Northern Dropseed (*Sporobolus heterolepis*) – 3' – Dry-Moist soil

Bottom (wet)

- Cream Gentian (*Gentiana flavida*) – 3' – Cream – Aug-Sept – Dry-Moist
- *Crooked-Stemmed Aster (*Aster prenanthoides*) – 3' – Lavender – Aug-Oct – Med-Moist
- Drummond's Aster (*Aster drummondii*) – 3' – Blue or White – Sep-Oct – Dry-Moist
- Great Blue Lobelia (*Lobelia siphilitica*) – 3' – Blue – Jul-Oct – Med-Wet
- Northern Blue Flag Iris (*Iris versicolor*) – 3' – Blue – May-July – Med-Wet
- *Orange Coneflower (*Rudbeckia fulgida*) – 3' – Orange – Jul-Sep – Dry-Moist
- Prairie Alumroot (*Heuchera richardsonii*) – 2-3' – White – May-Jul – Dry-Moist
- *Prairie Phlox (*Phlox pilosa*) – 2' – Pink – May-Jul – Dry-Wet (use throughout garden)
- *Riddell's Goldenrod (*Solidago riddellii*) – 3' – Yellow – Aug-Oct – Med-Wet
- *Rosin Weed (*Silphium integrifolium*) – 3' – Yellow – Jul-Sep – Dry-Moist
- Southern Blue Flag/Wild Iris (*Iris shrevei*) – 3' – Light Blue – May-July – Med-Wet
- *Spiderwort (*Tradescantia ohiensis*) – 3' – Blue – May-July – Dry-Wet
- *Virginia Mountain Mint (*Pycnanthemum virginianum*) – 3' – White – Jun-Sep – Med-Wet

Grasses/Sedges

- Bebb's Oval Sedge (*Carex bebbii*) – 3' – Med-Moist
- Brown Fox Sedge (*Carex vulpinoidea*) – 3' – Dry-Wet
- Common Bur/Gray's Sedge (*Carex grayi*) – 3' – Moist-Wet
- Field Oval Sedge (*Carex molesta*) – 3' – Dry-Moist
- Palm Sedge (*Carex muskingumensis*) – 2-3' – Med-Wet
- Porcupine Sedge (*Carex hystericina*) – 3' – Moist-Wet
- Sweet Grass (*Hierochloe odorata*) – 2' – Med-Wet
- Torrey's Rush (*Juncus torreyi*) – 1' – Med-Moist



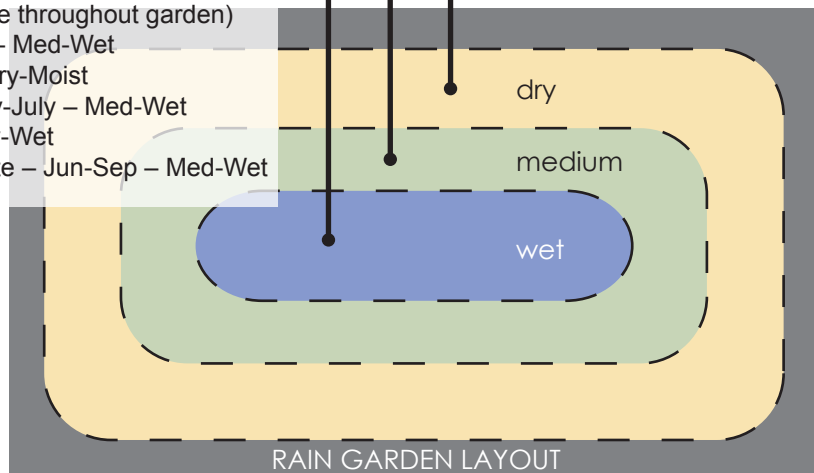
Notes:

Follow spacing guidelines for each plant species, or assume 12-18" spacing.

All plant species except Hosta are Wisconsin natives.

Gardens may require watering during the first year until their roots are established.

Bloom times may vary.
