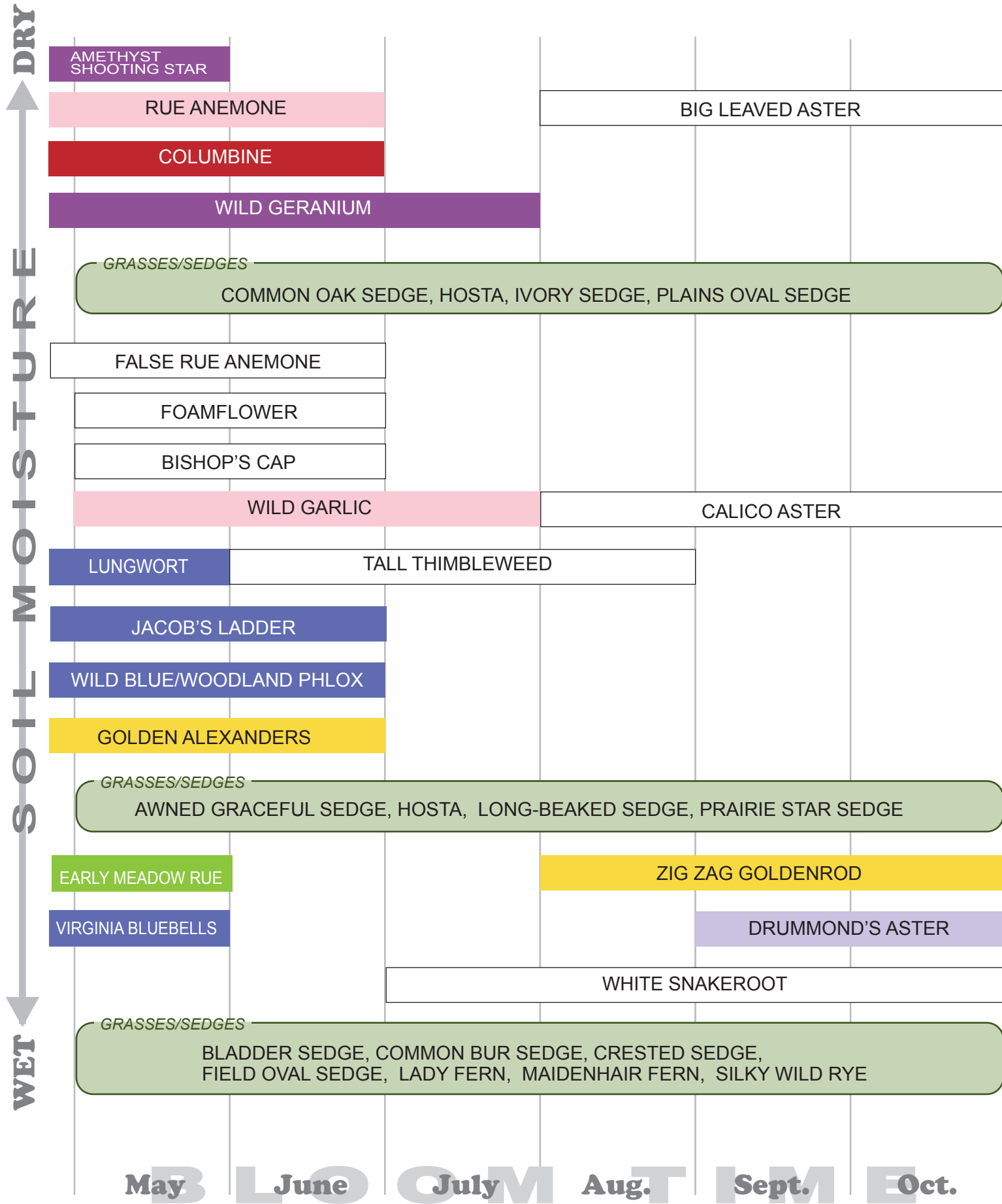


# RAIN GARDEN PLANTS

# FULL SHADE



COLOR OF BARS INDICATE COLOR OF BLOOM; PLANTS LISTED ARE GENERALLY 3' TALL OR LESS; BLOOM TIMES INDICATED MAY VARY SLIGHTLY; SOME PLANTS ARE ADAPTABLE TO A RANGE OF MOISTURE LEVELS; SEE BACK FOR MORE INFO



**Top (dry)**

- Amethyst Shooting Star (*Dodecatheon amethystinum*) – 1’ – Violet – Apr-May – Dry-Med
- Big-leaved Aster (*Aster macrophyllus*) – 1’ – White – Aug-Oct – Dry-Moist
- Columbine (*Aquilegia canadensis*) – 2’ – Red/yellow – Apr-Jun – Dry-Med
- Rue Anemone (*Amemonella thalictroides*) – 6” – Pink – Apr-Jun – Dry-Med
- Wild Geranium (*Geranium maculatum*) – 1’ – Apr-July – Lavender – Dry-Med

**Grasses/Sedges**

- Common Oak Sedge/Pennsylvania Sedge (*Carex pennsylvanica*) – 8” – Dry-Med
- Hosta (*Hosta sp.*) - varies
- Ivory Sedge (*Carex eburnea*) – 6” – Dry-Med

**Middle (medium)**

- Bishop’s Cap (*Mitella diphylla*) – 1-2’ – White – May-Jun – Dry-Med
- Calico Aster (*Aster lateriflorus*) – 1-3’ – White – Aug-Oct – Dry-Med
- False Rue Anemone (*Isopyrum biternatum*) – 6’ – White – Apr-Jun – Med-Moist
- Golden Alexanders (*Zizia aurea*) – 3’ – Yellow – Apr-Jun – Dry-Med
- Jacob’s Ladder (*Polemonium reptans*) – 1’ – Blue – Apr-Jun – Dry-Wet
- Tall Thimbleweed (*Anemone lateriflorus*) – 3’ – White – Jun-Aug – Dry-Med
- Wild Blue/Woodland Phlox (*Phlox divaricata*) – 1’ – Blue – Apr-Jun – Dry-Med
- Wild Garlic (*Allium canadense*) – 18” – Pink – May-July – Dry-Moist

**Grasses/Sedges**

- Awned Graceful Sedge (*Carex davisii*) – 2-3’ – Med-Moist
- Hosta (*Hosta sp.*) - varies
- Long-Beaked Sedge (*Carex sprengelii*) – 2’ – Dry-Moist
- Prairie Star Sedge (*Carex interior*) – 2’ – Med-Wet

**Bottom (wet)**

- Drummond’s Aster (*Aster drummondii*) – 3’ – Blue or White – Sep-Oct – Dry-Moist
- Early Meadow Rue (*Thalictrum dioicum*) – 2’ – Green – Apr-May – Dry-Moist
- Virginia Bluebells (*Mertensia virginica*) – 2’ – Blue – Apr-May – Med-Moist
- White Snakeroot (*Eupatorium rugosum*) – 2’ – White – Jul-Oct – Dry-Moist
- Zig Zag Goldenrod (*Solidago flexicaulis*) – 3’ – Yellow – Aug-Oct – Dry-Wet

**Grasses/Sedges**

- Bladder Sedge (*Carex intumescens*) – 2-3’ – Med-Wet
- Common Bur/Gray’s Sedge (*Carex grayi*) – 3’ – Moist-Wet
- Crested Oval Sedge (*Carex cristatella*) – 3’ – Med-Wet
- Field Oval Sedge (*Carex molesta*) – 3’ – Dry-Moist
- Lady Fern (*Athyrium filix-femina*) – 18” – Med-Moist
- Maidenhair Fern (*Adiantum pedatum*) – 2’ – Med-Moist
- Silky Wild Rye (*Elymus villosus*) – 3’ – Dry-Moist

**Notes:**

Follow spacing guidelines for each plant species, or assume 12-18” spacing.

All plant species except Hosta are Wisconsin natives.

Gardens may require watering during the first year until their roots are established.

Bloom times may vary.
