1. Yahara WINS/Chlorides Update (Lake)

Kathy Lake said that the Yahara WINS is working towards approving the 2017 service agreement. Additionally, they have a long term agreement with Dane County Land and Water to broker the agreement. Updates to the water quality models will need to be approved by September 1st for 2017 billing. Eric Rortvedt is currently reviewing 4 models and is on track to get these completed by 9/1.

MMSD is soliciting projects for 2017 Yahara Wins Grants.

MMSD is providing a rebate for chloride reduction by their industrial rate payers. This rebate is \$1/lb. There will be a salt reduction workshop on 10/ 24-25/ 2016 at the MMSD Maintenance Training Facility. Equipment operators are encouraged to bring their equipment to the workshop.

2. Monona Rain Barrel Workshop (Braun)

Brad Braun discussed the rain barrel workshop that the City of Monona held. They had 65 participants and 30 of the 65 indicated that they either had already installed or were planning to install a rain barrel.

4. Access to Rainfall Data (Balousek, Eilertson)

Balousek described the network of private weather stations that the county utilizes to create detailed maps of rain fall variability across the county. This information can be found at www.infosyahara.org. John Reimer at Dane County reimer.john@countyofdane.com can be contacted for old data. This information can be used to trigger erosion control inspections.

Eilertson stated that Fitchburg was hit hard with the 7/21 storm and that they performed a critical duration analysis for parts of the system. If anyone is interested in incorporating critical duration analysis into their ordinances they should reach out to Jeremy or Rick.

5. Additional Topic – the Village of Cross Plains joining the I&E component of the Permit (Campbell)

Campbell explained the Cross Plains would like to participate in the I & E component of the MaMSWAPP permit. Rick Eilertson Moved to accept. Greg Fries Seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
