

TABLE 1 DESIGN EXERCISE – CONCEPT A




Like = ● (green)

- Mixed feelings on the enclosed swimming area and support structure but recognize that it is good for little kids.



Report out Comments:

- Want a separate T-shaped swimming pier for fishing and one for boating.
- Like angled shelter but would like to see it mirrored.
- Would like to preserve views along shorelines. If native plants are installed along shoreline they should be shorter.
- Would like to increase lighting in parking lot.
- Liked option A better.
- Foot wash should be on concrete away from sand and away from people sitting at shelter.
- Play area should be closer to shelter.

TABLE 2 DESIGN EXERCISE – CONCEPT B





- Also okay with short native vegetation along parts of the shoreline.



Report out Comments:

- The location of the fishing pier should be where the canoe/kayak access is located and the canoe/kayak access should be moved closer to the beach area.
- Fishing access is important. The area along the shoreline at the parking lot, to the lagoon is very popular for fishing.
- Would like non cottonwood trees planted on the south side of the lagoon outlet.
- When a tree was removed which allowed sunlight to the lagoon outlet area the fishing conditions changed.
- Bike rack too close to parking lot, move it closer to the shelter.
- Like shower, don't like the position of the shelter because it doesn't shade folks from noon to 7 pm which is when it's most used. Want overhand facing east for shade.
- Bridge over lagoon inlet not needed.
- Liked a little of option A and option B.





- Would like shower and footwash to be next to pavement along path as opposed to near sand.
- Would like sidewalk connection from Woodward to shelter.
- Would like cut out for bike path and connection to bike racks so that bikers don't have to go through parking lot.
- Bike racks should be near shelter.
- Question on natural play area.
- Place the canoe racks closer to the road or in parking lot so they are not an eyesore along the shoreline.
- Want more canoe and kayak racks closer to road.
- Questions on cost of enclosed swimming area vs. cleaning lake/beach more often.
